Refunds will be processed within fifteen (15) business days.

DURHAM RECREATION & PARK DISTRICT

DRPD contributes to the quality of life for the District's residents by providing recreation and leisure time activities and opportunities throughout the year. The District is also responsible for designing, building, and maintaining public facilities including, parks, pools, and buildings.

AREAS SERVED

The District makes up 220 square miles of unincorporated Butte County, including the communities of Dayton, Durham and Nelson. The population of the District is approximately five-thousand persons. Butte Community College is located within the District, near Pentz and Clark Roads.

FACILITIES

Durham Community Park: This is Durham's oldest park. Established in 1918 and taken over by the District in 1947, it consists of twenty-four acres. It features covered and uncovered picnic areas, a play structure, two ball fields, and horse arena. The park is located on the Durham-Dayton Highway.

Ravekes Park: This is a small, one half acre park that was donated to the District in 1982 by John Ravekes. The park is located east of the Dwight Brinson Swim Center and consists of a small play area and tennis court.

Louis Edwards Park: This is a 3.86 acre park site. The Dwight Brinson Swim Center and the District administrative offices are located at this park. It features four picnic tables.

Nelson Park: This small park is located seven miles south of Durham, in the unincorporated community of Nelson. It features a small picnic area and a swing set.

Midway Park: The District completed the initial stages of development on the new park located on the Midway and adjacent to school property in 1998. The park is open for use by the public and sports programs run through the D.R.P.D. and the Durham Unified School District.

Durham Memorial Hall: The District maintains and uses the Memorial hall for special events, programs, and meetings. This facility is host to the Durham Legion organization for their meetings and functions. The Memorial Hall consists of a kitchen, large meeting room, Legion meeting room, main floor, and stage area.

Jim Brinson Activity Center: In the Spring of 2017, the District began construction of a new 7400 multi-purpose activity center located at the south end of the 4.8 acre parcel, adjacent to Ravekes Park. The building was opened to the public in the fall of 2017. The new facility provides for after school based programs, indoor recreational opportunities, and meeting spaces.
